

How to reach the venue

From downtown:

The best way to reach the venue from the city centre is by bus. Go to the closest bus stop on Slovenska cesta (Bavarski dvor, Ajdovščina...) and you can take buses number 6 or 8 (directions: Črnuče; Brnčičeva) towards north. The bus stop (Smelt) is in front of the Austria Trend Hotel. The ride takes approximately 9 minutes. You can also walk along Slovenska and Dunajska cesta, around 3.5 km (50 min).



ARRIVING TO LJUBLJANA BY PLANE

Ljubljana International Airport is located about 25 km north-west of Ljubljana. Sometimes it's worth checking for more affordable flights to neighbouring airports (Trieste, Venice, Zagreb and Klagenfurt) but you have to keep longer transfer times in mind. The best way to reach the city from the airport is by airport shuttle or taxi. A shuttle typically costs €10 / person and a taxi €30-35 (you have to book both in advance with one of the shuttle or taxi providers below, otherwise prices may double). The ride to the city centre takes approximately 25 minutes. Usually you can be dropped at the hotel even when taking the shuttle service.

Shuttle transfers

First two offer affordable shuttle transfers to and from Ljubljana Airport and to and from major airports and train stations in Slovenia (Ljubljana) and neighbouring countries (Trieste, Venice, Zagreb, Graz, Klagenfurt, Vienna and Munich).

Prices usually increase closer to the day of departure so try to book well in advance. Shuttles collect several passengers in a certain time window. At the time of the booking you can select the length of the time you are ready to wait for other passengers (fix time or up to two hours, prices change accordingly).

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

Ljubljana has many train connections (especially from neighbour countries Austria, Hungary and Croatia, but also Germany and Switzerland). However, taking a bus or a shuttle might be a faster option. If you are arriving from Italy, we recommend taking the train to Trieste and continuing with a direct shuttle (Go Opti, Nomago).

ARRIVING BY CAR

Ljubljana is located at the intersection of all main Slovenian traffic routes, making it convenient to reach the city by car. A **vignette** (€15/week) is required on Slovenian highways and can be bought at all service stations and dedicated locations at the border. The vignette has to be applied to the inner side of the windshield before entering any of Slovenia's highways. The fines for driving without the sticker are exceptionally high (€300–800)!

PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN LJUBLJANA

Payment for the use of public transport in Ljubljana can only be made through the use of Urbana public transport card. You <u>cannot</u> pay for a bus ride in cash on a bus!

The Urbana card can be obtained in physical form from green stand-alone machines at the bus stops "Urbanomats", LPP ticket offices, tourist information offices, most of newspaper kiosks and post offices for €2. A single journey fare costs €1.30 and covers a 90-minute one-way travel including interchanging buses.

BicikeLJ (city bike)

Another fast option to move around Ljubljana is BicikeLJ (city bike – a bike sharing service). Weekly subscription costs €1. Bikes can be used for one hour free of charge, which should suffice for transfer to any of the bike stations in the city. Bike stations are located all over Ljubljana at the distance of 300-500 m. OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

Drinking water: Everywhere in Slovenia, tap water is clean and of very good quality so there is no need to purchase bottled water. You can find several public drinking fountains all over the city.

Currency: The currency in Slovenia is Euro (€). ATMs are widely available in the city. Currency exchange bureau is available at the airport.

Free WiFi is also available in many cafés and restaurants.
